Foundation giving for developing countries includes grants awarded to recipients based in developing countries and for U.S.-based international programs benefiting developing countries. Countries were identified as "developing" based on the OECD's list of DAC Aid Recipients.

OECD = Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development, which represents most of the major industrial countries of the world, including the United States.

DAC = Development Assistance Committee, the committee of the OECD that deals with development cooperation.
