Countries were identified as "developing" based on the OECD's list of DAC Aid Recipients.

Note: Figures include all areas of assistance, such as economic and agricultural development, education, health, environment, humanitarian aid, and government and civil society, among others.

OECD = Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development, which represents most of the major industrial countries of the world, including the United States.

DAC = Development Assistance Committee, the committee of the OECD that deals with development cooperation.
