

What areas does the Birmingham Directory cover?

The Birmingham Directory covers zip code areas 15203, 15210, and 15211. Thirteen communities are included in these three zip codes: Allentown, Arlington, Arlington Heights, Beltzhoover, Bon Air, Carrick, Duquesne Heights, Knoxville, Mt. Washington, Mt. Oliver Boro, South Side Flats, South Side Slopes, and St. Clair Village.

Which organizations are listed in the Birmingham Directory?

Only organizations that are located in or have a service focus in the South Pittsburgh area. This includes nonprofit organizations, public agencies, and community groups. For-profit groups and individuals are not listed in the *Directory*.

Description of Categories

Category	Types of Agencies Listed
Children/Youth Services	Agencies and groups that provide programs and support services for children, youth, and families.
Civic/Neighborhood	Community development corporations, neighborhood councils, and nonprofits providing a civic service in the community.
Employment/Training Services	Agencies and groups that provide employment assistance, training, career development and education.
Food Pantries	Nonprofit groups, agencies, and churches that host food pantries.
Health Services	Nonprofit agencies and groups that provide health and wellness services; includes healthcare clinics, mental health providers, and outreach programs.
Human Services	Agencies and groups that provide assistance and resources for community residents, including supportive services, counseling, housing services, and referrals.
Safety Net/Assistance Services	Agencies and groups that provide assistance or screening for food, utility, employment assistance, etc.
Senior Services	Agencies and groups that provide services and supports targeted towards older adults.
