MARPAT FOUNDATION WARD 7 AND 8 INITIATIVE

GUIDELINES

In 2008, in collaboration with the Community Foundation for the National Capital Region, MARPAT will be considering applications from organizations that focus on the following priorities benefiting residents of Wards 7 and 8:

- Education and youth development/ enrichment
- Employment, ESOL, literacy including financial literacy
- Family support and child development
- Health/mental health
- Housing/homelessness
- Substance abuse treatment and prevention
- Violence prevention and victim advocacy
- Advocacy for city-wide policy changes that will benefit Wards 7 and 8

In addition to The MARPAT Foundation Stage One Summary Sheet due on or before MAY 27, all applicants to the Ward 7 and 8 Initiative must also complete a 1-page addendum, which may be found at www.foundationcenter.org/grantmaker/marpat.

Applications focused on these issues from organizations based in and serving other DC wards or other parts of the region will be accepted only if invited by MARPAT.
